Once matched with SME's V arm and van den Hul's MC One Special cartridge, this steel wheel cruises effortlessly through everything from jazz to rock, bringing music to life in a thrilling man-



ner. Sonic pictures have immense solidity, detail retrieval is exemplary, and dynamics and punch are huge.
